## The men's alpine ski World Cup makes its grand return to Courchevel

Courchevel is delighted to host the men's alpine ski World Cup on 14 and 15 March 2026, a prestigious event that the resort has not organised since 1979 (apart from the 2022 World Cup Finals and the 2023 FIS World Championships). Two major races, downhill and super-G, will take place on the legendary Éclipse course, which hosted the 2022 World Cup Finals and the men's events of the 2023 FIS World Championships.

A true jewel of technical excellence, the Éclipse impresses with its demanding layout: 3.2 kilometres in length, nearly 1,000 metres of vertical drop, and a succession of high-speed sections, shifting light and shadow, making it the ultimate test of skill and courage for the world's best skiers.

The return of the men's World Cup to Courchevel reflects the resort's ongoing sporting commitment, on the eve of the 2030 Olympic Games, and further confirms its status as a leading alpine destination.

The organising committee warmly thanks the media for their interest and continued support.

## COURSE DETAILS

### Le saut du Zénith

The world's best downhill skiers have already passed four gates by the time they reach this bump. A first jump follows, offering a breathtaking view of Mont Blanc before plunging into the next steep section.

### Le S des Arolles

A curve stretching over 200 metres, one of the course's signature features, with true chicanes where you won't always see the exit.

### Le trou noir

A highly evocative name for a section where you suddenly plunge into the shadow of the forest.

### Le mur du son

Skiers reach it at full speed, having built up momentum on the upper section of the course.

### Le saut des jockeys

This jump launches professional skiers 50 metres through the air before they land on a steep, shaded section. It is undoubtedly the biggest jump on the Éclipse course !

### Le mur de la bux

The penultimate wall of the course, this is where the most seasoned skiers truly let loose, with gradients reaching up to 58% at their steepest.

### L'envol

Above the Olympic ski jumps of Le Praz, this jump propels the champions a little closer to the finish area.

### Le mur des braves

It is the steepest and most spectacular wall on the course, drawing attention one final time and sending the athletes into the ultimate schuss to conclude this exceptional downhill run !

# Media Center



## L'Envolée sports hall

This venue centralises all services related to the event's press operations, including accreditation collection. It is also where media arrival and check-in take place.


Located at the L'Envolée sports hall, in the ski jump stadium area next to the Éclipse finish area, the media centre brings together all services dedicated to the press. Facilities include a working area, a cafeteria and restrooms.

The media centre is open from Tuesday 10 March to Sunday 15 March.

# Media services

## General information

The media centre, as well as the website, will provide both general information about the races and all specific information intended for the media.

## Workstations

Workstations are available at the L'Envolée sports hall. The press room has a capacity of 90 seats, each equipped with power outlets.

## Internet

The media centre is equipped with high-speed Wi-Fi. The password is available at the media reception desk.

## Catering

In the media centre cafeteria, coffee, tea, water and soft drinks are available free of charge throughout the day.

Lunch catering is included on race days.

Catering on training days (Tuesday 10, Wednesday 11, Thursday 12 and Friday 13) is available upon reservation: €30 incl. VAT per person (*payable on site by credit card only*).

## Parking

Reserved parking spaces for the media are available, subject to availability. When not located in the immediate vicinity, a shuttle service operates between these car parks and the finish stadium.

Parking permits are allocated in advance by the press team during the accreditation process and are issued at check-in at the L'Envolée media centre. No access to the stadium by private vehicle is permitted.

Additional shuttle services will operate from La Tania to Le Praz.

## Ski lifts

The Le Praz and Grangettes gondola lifts (Courchevel Village) will be free of charge on race days.

## Ski passes

Upon request, lift passes can be provided to facilitate access to the course. If you wish to benefit from this service, please inform us as soon as possible.

***There will be no press conference after the races.***

***Media requests will be handled directly in the mixed zone.***



# Photographers

## Armbands

Photographers selected by the chief photographer and accredited by the press team may collect their armband at the L'Envolée Sports Hall (**against a €10 deposit or an ID document**).

To access the course, photographers must wear their numbered armband at all times. The armband must be returned to the media centre at the end of the races.

*In the event of non-compliance with the photographers' regulations (available on the FIS website), the race organisation reserves the right to withdraw the armband from the photographer concerned. A serious breach may also result in the withdrawal of accreditation.*

# Image and TV rights

## Armbands

Broadcasters selected by Infront and accredited by the press team may collect their armband at the L'Envolée Sports Hall (**against a €10 deposit or an ID document**).

To access the course, broadcasters must wear their numbered armband at all times. The armband must be returned to the media centre at the end of the races.

*In the event of non-compliance with the broadcasters' regulations (available on the FIS website), the race organisation reserves the right to withdraw the armband from the broadcaster concerned. A serious breach may also result in the withdrawal of accreditation.*

Please note that by submitting your accreditation request, you agree to comply with **Infront's broadcasting regulations**.

Only photographers accredited by the organisation are authorised to take professional photographs.

Only official TV rights holders, with formal authorisation from Infront, are permitted to film the competition.
